## **CONDITIONAL HISTORIC REGISTRATION**

### **Process for Conditional (Club) Historic Registration:**

Firstly, you need to present your car, along with the current “Registration Details Certificate”, your driving licence and Club membership card to one of the Club Conditional Registration Officers (CHRO).

The CHRO will review your car and paperwork and if all is ok, will then fill out an MR334 Form, which you need to present to Service SA at the time of changing over the rego to conditional historic.

An invoice will also be issued by the Club for the purchase of the Club Rego Logbook which you are required to have. This is currently a cost of **\$12.00**

Once you have changed the SA registration into Conditional Historic, you will be given a new “Registration Details Certificate” and once you are in possession of this – you need you to send the Club Secretary a copy of it (good photo or scan) to: [clubreg@bmwdcsa.org.au](mailto:clubreg@bmwdcsa.org.au)

On receipt of that, and payment for the logbook, we will then proceed to issue the logbook, duly validated, signed, and stamped – after which it will be mailed out to you by registered mail.

Remember, you are only permitted to use the vehicle to a maximum of 90 days in each year of registration and you must fill out an entry, prior to commencement of usage, before you set off on each day’s usage.

Also, the logbook has to be revalidated annually at the same time as you renew your Club membership, which must be kept financial in order to have a legally registered car on conditional historic registration.

This means that the next time your membership, you will have to present your logbook for a Year2 membership validation (and again one year later). This is done at either a Club event or members meeting.

After the end of the third year of membership expiring, you are required to have another logbook issued.

### **So, when can the MR334 be issued?**

There are two options for you.

- a) Attend the next Coffee & Cars or Coffee & Club Rego events which take place on Sunday mornings as listed on the Club website

or

- b) Attend the next Club Members Meeting on third Wednesday of each month (except Dec & Jan) from 06:30pm onwards. This is at the Austin 7 Clubrooms, 262 Tapleys Hill Road, Seaton

Check the Club Website, under Events for the applicable dates.

In either case, you will need to let the Conditional Registrations Manager know which event you are attending, so we can ensure a CHRO is in attendance to complete the issuing of the MR334 Form.
